### More about activities in this month

- **Club Membership:** The deadline for the submission of applications for club membership is 11 Shrawan (27 July). Collegiate clubs aim to increase the participation of students in varied co-curricular and extracurricular activities that enrich them in body, mind, and spirit. The selection of club members is based upon interest or experience. Application forms are available for all Trinitians at the Reception w.e.f. 8 Shrawan (24 July).
- **A Levels – CAIE Exam Registration:** The deadline for entry submission for A and AS level exams for the October/November 2018 session is 11 Shrawan (27 July). Candidates must complete their registration forms and get them checked by the Admin Officer before submission.
- **Grade XII & A2 (Science) – Medical & Engineering Entrance Preparation - Submission of Names:** The deadline for Medical & Engineering Entrance Preparation Submission of Names is 12 Shrawan (28 July). Medical & Engineering Entrance Preparation commences on 19 Shrawan (4 August). Our distinctive synergistic teaching-learning approach has made these preparation classes vital for students competing in medical & engineering entrance tests. They are equally important for paramedical and other technical entrance tests. Interested students would need to appear for the Model Test on 12 Shrawan (28 July) before they join classes.
- **Grade XII & A2 (Management) – Management Training & Entrance Preparation - Submission of Names:** The College provides CMAT Preparation, CA Foundation, General Banking Training, and Seminars & Presentations for interested students. Students who wish to avail of these introductory courses should register their names at the Reception by 17 Shrawan (2 August).
- **Intra-College Competitions:** During this month three Intra-College competitions are held – Essay writing competition 18 Shrawan (3 August), Debate 28 Shrawan (13 August) and Chess 31 Shrawan - 2 Bhadra (16 - 18 August). Interested students must register in the week preceding each of these competitions.
- **Tutorials:** The College provides regular tutorials during college hours as an integral part of its formal teaching consisting of lectures & tutorials. Study & exam tips along with revision notes too are provided.
- **Extra Tutorial Classes:** Extra tutorial classes, in particular subjects as recommended by teachers, are also arranged for those students who need to learn more so as to improve their academic performance and to do better in Term, Board, and University examinations. The College publishes need-based class schedules. Attendance is mandatory. These classes start on 26 Shrawan (11 August).
- **Annual General Meeting (AGM) –** The Annual General Meeting of Trinity Alumni Association—is on 26 Shrawan (11 August). The President of the Association will present the Annual Report followed by miscellaneous programmes.
- **Class Tests:** Test for Grade XII start on 27 Shrawan (12 August). The Tests are a regular feature of the assessment of student assimilation of course content and have a weightage in the First Terminal Evaluation of each student. The result of the Test will be published on 11 Bhadra (27 August).
- **Magazines – Publication:** Infinity, a comprehensive bilingual magazine published annually with articles in different genres; Enlightenment, a thematic magazine about special events or days and issues; and, The Trinitian, a magazine which covers matters of general interest to students and promotes articles by students themselves. Hard copies of Infinity are distributed to all students while Enlightenment and The Trinitian are wall magazines that are displayed. - **Articles or related materials – Submission:** The submission of articles by students for College magazines is open throughout the year. Students would need to indicate the magazine/s and/or forthcoming issues such as Infinity, Enlightenment, The Trinitian, and others in which they would like their articles to be considered for publication.
- **Student Planners:** The deadline for the submission of Planners to the respective Director/Coordinator/Class Teacher for periodic evaluation is normally at the end of each month, i.e. 31 Shrawan (16 August) for this month. Every student must also remember to bring his or her Planner to College daily.

Revision Classes for CAIE Exams *A2 Level*

### More about activities in this month

- Class Tests:** Test for AS Level start on 6 Bhadra (22 August) and for Grade XI start on 14 Bhadra (30 August). The Tests are a regular feature of the assessment of student assimilation of course content and have a weightage in the First Terminal Evaluation of each student. The result of the Test will be published on 17 Bhadra (2 September) and 31 Bhadra (16 September) respectively.
- Results and Parents-Teachers' Meeting & Interaction – A2 Level:** The Result Distribution Program of the First Term Examination is on 6 Bhadra (22 August). Parents-Teachers' Meetings & Interaction are held during this program to facilitate student academic progress and to incorporate parental feedback.
- Traffic Safety Awareness:** Trinity will be organizing traffic education reflecting local needs and accident problems on 8 Bhadra (24 August). We believe that safety skills can provide lifelong benefits both to students and society.
- A Levels – Past Questions (Booklets) Distribution:** The College distributes booklets containing questions from previous CAIE examinations in the third week of this month. Students are expected to answer a fair number of questions for their teachers to assess. This greatly helps students to perform well in the main examinations. The College distributes these Booklets on 8 Bhadra (24 August).
- A Levels – Mock Examinations:** Mock Examinations for A Levels students who would be appearing for A and AS level exams (October/November 2018 session) will commence from 12 Bhadra (28 August). It is compulsory for students to sit for the Mock Examination for each of the subjects they would be taking in the session. The results of Mock Examinations are important in forecasting grades as a realistic prediction of what the candidates are expected to achieve in the CAIE examinations.
- Awareness Programme: Stress Management:** This program is to help students to cope with every day stress so as to perform better & to promote their well-being. The program will be held on 15 Bhadra (31 August).
- Intra-College Competitions:** During this month three Intra-College competitions are held – Badminton competition 21-23 Bhadra (6-8 September), Elocution 25 Bhadra (10 September) and Futsal Competition 28-30 Bhadra (13-15 September). Interested students must register in the week preceding each of these competitions.
- A Levels – Revision Classes for CAIE Exams:** The College conducts subject-wise revision classes for the CAIE Exam (October/November 2018 session). These classes start on 21 Bhadra (6 September). Students are obliged to attend these special classes.
- Welcome Programme:** The Welcome Programme is organized by the senior students for newly inducted juniors. Senior students candidly exchange their experience at the College and exhibit their talent in diverse ways. The Programme is on 24 Bhadra (9 September).
- Talk Programme:** The programme will be held on 26 Bhadra (11 September). The Talk programme highlights the contemporary issues incorporating the prospects and challenges for leading the nation towards a sustainable future.
- Grade XI – National Examination Board (NEB) Registration:** The deadline for NEB Registration is 31 Bhadra (16 September). All the newly enrolled Grade XI students must fill up their NEB Registration Forms by this date in compliance with NEB regulations. Students must submit their Registration Forms along with photocopies of their SEE/Equivalent Grade/Mark sheets plus Character Certificates and four PP size photos (3.5 x 4.5 cm) and NEB Registration Fees. Original Grade/Mark sheets and Character Certificates must also be shown to the Admin Officer at the time of the submission of these photocopied documents. Please submit your Forms well in time during this week instead of the last day.
- Student Planners:** The deadline for the submission of Planners to the respective Director/Coordinator/Class Teacher for periodic evaluation is 31 Bhadra (16 September). It must also be kept in mind that every student must bring his or her Planner to College daily.

- **MOE Registration – A Levels:** The deadline for MOE Registration for AS & A2 Levels is 2 Ashwin (18 September). All A Levels students must get registered according to MOE regulations. They should submit photocopies of their SEE/Equivalent Grade/Mark sheets plus Character Certificates and two PP size photos and MOE Registration Fees. Original Grade/Mark sheets and Character Certificates must also be shown to the Admin Officer at the time of the submission of these photocopied documents. Students may also note that the College verifies scholarship documents at this time.
- **Intra-College Competitions:** During this month three Intra-College competitions are held – Web Designing Competition 3 Ashwin (19 September), Short Story Writing Competition 5 Ashwin (21 September) and Cricket Tournament 6 Ashwin (22 September). The College publishes need-based class schedules. Attendance is mandatory. These classes are conducted from 8 to 19 Kartik (25 October - 5 November).
- **Academic Counseling:** The College oversees students' academic performance during the First Term and provides related counseling from 11-19 Kartik (28 October - 5 November) except the holidays. It must also be noted that both academic and personal counseling are available to all students throughout each academic session. Appointments need to be fixed with the Admin Officer.
- **Autumn Camp:** Camp is an opportunity for students to be engaged in & explore areas of their interest. The College would like to give exposure to & experience of beneficial activities. ## More about activities in this month

- **Grades XI & XII – Pre-Board Examinations:** The Pre-Board Examination for Grades XI & XII start from 1 Chaitra (15 March). This decisive examination follows the exact NEB pattern based on a set of model Board Examination papers and measures student performance during the academic session. It is stipulated that a student would need to clear the Pre-Board Examination to appear for the Board Examination in Baishakh. The results of this Examination govern both the award of fresh scholarships and the continuance, or not, of given scholarships.
- **AS Level – Class Tests:** These Tests start on 4 Chaitra (18 March). These Tests are a regular feature of the appraisal of student assimilation of course content and have a weightage in the Evaluation of each student.
- **A Levels – Mock Examinations:** Mock Examinations for A Levels students who would be appearing for A and AS level exams (May/June 2019 session) will commence from 10 Chaitra (24 March). It is compulsory for students to sit for the Mock Examination for each of the subjects they would be taking in the session. It must be noted these Mock Examinations are mandatory for A2 students.
- **Grades XI & XII – Sample Test Questions Consultation:** Students should consult their subject teachers, finally, if there is any point needing clarification or instruction w.e.f. 10 & 24 Chaitra (24 March & 7 April) for Grades XII and XI respectively. It is essential that they should have done all questions in the Sample Test Question booklet according to the procedure for test completion before such consultation.
- **Trinity Alumni Reunion:** We welcome all our graduates to be with us for the Reunion. This visit to your alma mater will help impart what you have learned to your juniors, the Trinitians, and exchange your ideas and experience with us. We wish to build a place where the alumni of Trinity can share memories, re-connect with one another, plan get-togethers, catch up on the news of our growing institution – and more! The reunion is on 22 Chaitra (5 April). Invitation cards may please be collected from the College after pre-registration.
- **Grades XI & XII – Results and Parents-Teachers' Meeting & Interaction:** The Result Distribution Programs of the Pre-Board Examination will be held on 23 Chaitra (6 April). All parents or guardians along with their wards should attend this function during which Parents-Teachers' Meetings & Interaction are held to accelerate student academic progress and to take into account parental feedback.
- **Grades XI & XII – Academic Counseling:** The College oversees students' overall academic performance during the academic session and provides related counseling from 24 Chaitra (7 April). During this period, the College allots specific time for students. Parents or guardians may also accompany their wards. It must also be noted that both academic and personal counseling are available to all students – individually or, if need be, even group-wise, on demand, throughout each academic session as counseling at Trinity is an ongoing process. Appointments need to be fixed with the Admin Officer.
- **A Levels – Revision Classes for CAIE Exams:** The College conducts subject-wise revision classes for the CAIE Exam (May/June 2019 session). These classes start on 24 Chaitra (7 April). Students are obliged to attend these special classes.
- **Student Online Feedback – Academic Session:** Students may please give their online feedback for the entire academic session starting on 28 Chaitra (11 April) from their login accounts. Your useful observations will help the College to plan better and improve its performance for your future benefit. We expect students to give candid comments and valuable suggestions.
- **Deadline: Alumni – Graduate Admissions:** The College requests its graduates to inform it about their admissions for their further studies by 29 Chaitra (12 April). They may kindly provide information about the names of their institutions, the actual courses they are studying, and any other notable achievements including scholarships and awards. These details may also be required for incorporation in Trinity publications.

### More about activities in this month

- **Grade XI, XII & A Levels – Academic Counseling:** The College oversees students' academic performance during the academic session and provides related counseling from 24 Chaitra to 24 Baishakh (7 April – 7 May). During this period, the College allots specific time for students. Parents or guardians may also accompany their wards. It must also be noted that both academic and personal counseling are available to all students – individually or, if need be, even group-wise, on demand, throughout each academic session as counseling at Trinity is an ongoing process. Appointments need to be fixed with the Admin Officer.
- **Academic Consultation:** This is a subject-focused consultation period just before Board Exams both for Grades XI & XII. Subject teachers are available for their students in the respective departments during the allocated time from 24 Chaitra to 24 Baishakh (7 April – 7 May).
- **AS Level – Annual Internal Examination:** The Annual Internal Examination for the AS starts on 4 Baishakh (17 April). It is stipulated that AS students must clear this examination to be eligible to take A2 Level classes. The results of this Examination govern both the award of fresh scholarships and the continuance, or not, of given scholarships up to the First Terminal Examination of A2 Level.
- **A Levels – Results and Parents-Teachers' Meeting & Interaction:** The Result Distribution Programs of the Mock Examination is on 6 Baishakh (19 April). All parents or guardians along with their wards should attend this function during which Parents-Teachers' Meetings & Interaction are held to accelerate student academic progress and to take into account parental feedback.
- **Grades XI & XII – NEB Examination:** Board Examinations for Grades XI & XII take place in this month. The exam routine is notified by the NEB. Students have to obtain their Exam Entry Cards from the Admin Office a week before the exams start after completing due formalities.
- **A Levels – CAIE Exams Commencement:** CAIE Exams for the May/June 2019 session tentatively start on 20 Baishakh (3 May). Exam schedules are posted on the Notice Board. Students must obtain their Statement of Entry from Admin Office by 19 Baishakh (2 May) after completing due formalities.
- **A2 Level – Classes Commence:** The Academic Session 2019–20 commence on 27 Baishakh (10 May). This session is the second part of the two-year course and covers the other half of the course content for the completion of A Levels.
- **AS Level – Results and Parents-Teachers' Meeting & Interaction:** The Result Distribution Program of the AS Level will be held on 28 Baishakh (11 May). All parents or guardians along with their wards may kindly attend this function during which Parents-Teachers' Meetings & Interaction are held to assess student academic performance and to deliberate upon feedback.
- **International A Levels – ADMISSIONS OPEN:** Trinity invites students interested in joining A Levels in Science, Management, or Humanities at Trinity to apply during this month. Key dates such as those for Admission Form distribution and the Trinity Entrance Examinations will be declared immediately after the SEE/Grade X exams.

### More about activities in this month
